A young Russian lyric soprano, mechanic, native of St. Louis, will share the radio's dramatic fame on the "Metropolitan" program over WJZ Sunday at 6:30 p. m. with George Young.

War stories of how American war planes are performing on far-flung battle fronts; how a Japanese-born American citizen is fighting for the defeat of Japan; and how "defectives" are turned into first-class fighting men will be told on the "We, the People" program, Sunday, at 7:30 p. m. over WABC.

When Charley McCarthy learned the other night from Edgar Bergen that Gene Krupa, ace drummerman, would make a belated appearance on the program Sunday at 8 p. m. over WEAJ, he commented, "Well, that'll be the first pair of drumsticks I've seen since Christmas."

Latest of the movie stars to concentrate on a whirlwind round of radio is Ralph Bellamy. He is already booked for two important programs two nights in succession. The first is "Radio Reader's Digest" over WABC Sunday, at 9 p. m., when he'll star in a comedy, "The \$1,000 Bill," and the second is "Cavalcade of America" over WEAJ Monday at 8 p. m. when he'll be spotlighted in a war story, "Diary on a Pig Boat."

Judith Evelyn, harassed heroine of the current Broadway hit, "Angel Street," will doff the grease paint for her first guest star appearance on the "Inner Sanctum Mystery" series, Sunday, at 8:30 p. m. over WJZ.

Turning prophets, Phil Spitalny and his "Hour of Charm" all-girl orchestra, choir and soloists pick the hit songs for 1943, in their broadcast Sunday at 10 p. m. over WEAJ.

Col. Lemucl Q. Stoopnagle, who starts his "Stooparoos" on WABC Sunday, at 1:45 p. m., says the "Q" in his name stands for "Quixie Doodles" which he invented and which will be heard on his new programs.

Phil Baker, in his first public appearance since his recent appendectomy, will visit the Jack Benny broadcast over WEAJ Sunday at 7 p. m. Benny is in hopes that the surgeons removed some of the \$64 questions along with the offending organ.
