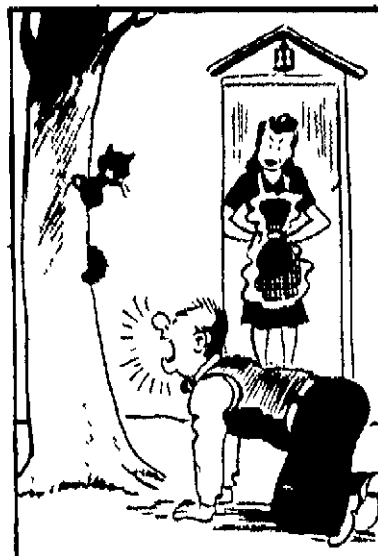

TAX DEFICIENCY CHARGED

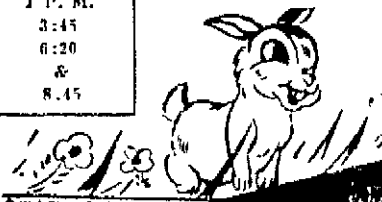
