PARMA SOLDIER CRASH VICTIM

SAN ANTONIO, Tex., March 2 (UPI) — Sgt. John Mezan, 23, of Parma, O., was one of eight army men killed last week-end in four separate plane crashes within the state of Texas, military authorities at Brooks Field announced today.

Mezan died in a crash five miles north of Yoakum, Tex., about midnight Sunday. He was a radio operator aboard the plane which authorities said was on a routine night training flight at the time of the crash.
