Marian Anderson will be guest star on the Great Artist series to be heard over WIBA at 8 tonight. Her solos will include Tschaikowsky's musical interpretation of Goethe's poem, "None But the Lonely Heart;" the spiritual, "I Was There When They Crucified My Lord;" Frank Laforge's "Hills," and Verdi's "O Don Fatal" from "Don Carlos." Donald Voorhees conducts the orchestra in Moussorgsky's "Gopak," Noel Coward's "I'll See You Again," and Mendelssohn's "Saltarello" from Symphony No. 4.
