During the eight-weeks lay-off, Ralph will do another picture for RKO, which produced his last film, "Seven Days Leave."

Joe Venuti, virtuoso of the swing violin, will visit "The Million Dollar Band," for a hand-clapping, dance-provoking half hour with Barr Wood, the Double Daters and the 34 select band players Saturday (WEAF, 10 p. m., EWT).

The cowboy Ernest Tubb sings a heart-touching ballad dedicated to his son, who was killed in an automobile accident when he sings "Our Baby Book" on the "Grand Ole Opry," on Saturday, at 10:30 p. m., EWT, over Station WEAFF.

The "U. S. Coast Guard on Parade" salutes the 26th anniversary of the landing of the first AEF division in World War I at Saint Nazaire on the weekly broadcast from the New London Coast Guard Academy Saturday (WEAF, 11:30 a. m., EWT). A musical salute to Gen. John J. Pershing will be made by the band directed by Lieut. Charles W. Messer.

A symphonic adaptation of the early American folk tune "Pop Goes the Weasel," by Cailliet, will highlight the Boston Pops orchestra program on Saturday, at 8:15 p. m., EWT, over WJZ.

A special program of all Viennese music will be played on "Saturday Concert," on Saturday, at 4 p. m., EWT, over WJZ.

"If They Come Tonight," a half-hour dramatic program based on problems which have been solved by the Office of Civilian Defense, will be heard over WEAFF for 13 weeks beginning Saturday (5 p. m., EWT). The title refers to the possibility of enemy planes raiding America.

Two of the upper bracket races of the American turf will be broadcast from the Aqueduct track, Long Island. On Saturday (5:15 p. m., EWT) McCarthy and Bill Stern will cover the 54th running of the Brooklyn Handicap, among the older features of American racing. It is the feature of the Aqueduct meet.
