Thomas W. Lamont, international banker, Thomas J. Watson, industrialist, and Eric A. Johnston, president of the U. S. Chamber of Commerce, will participate in the discussion of "Peace Through World Trade" on the program, "For This We Fight," to be heard at 6 tonight over WIBA. Lamont will act as chairman.

The speakers will explore the possibilities of business leading the way to permanent peace.
