

Mr. District Attorney Turns Attention To Bond Swindlers

Kay Kyser's College Of Musical Knowledge Will Visit Maritime Officers Training School

Racketeers who persuade munitions workers to cash in their War Bonds and use the money to buy phony stocks are the problem of "Mr. District Attorney," in "The Case of the War Bond Swindlers," on Wednesday at 9:30 p. m. over Station WEAZ. The racketeers in question compare the bonds' 2.9 per cent rate of interest with the higher rates paid by the stocks, but fail to point out that while the payoff on the bonds is definite, the payoff on the stocks never will come. With the help of his chief special investigator, Harrington (Len Doyle) and his secretary, Miss Miller (Vicki Vola) the "D. A." (Jay Jostyn) traps the unpatriotic swindlers. Jerry Devine writes and directs the series, and Peter Van Steeden conducts the music.

Kay Kyser takes his "College of Musical Knowledge" to the Maritime Officers' Training School in Alameda, Calif., on Wednesday. Airing will be heard over Station WEAZ at 10 p. m.
