

Wendell Willkie to Be Heard on WIBA Show Tonight at 7

Wendell Willkie will make his first appearance in an important radio drama in the air presentation of his own best-seller, "One World," to be heard at 7 tonight over WIBA.

The program is the second in the new Words at War series. During the program, Willkie will be heard three times as narrator. In the actual drama, the role of Willkie will be played by Thomas Chalmers, veteran radio actor, opera singer, and film commentator.

"One World," published on Apr. 8 of this year, was written after the author's return from his visit to the war fronts, and has sold faster than any book in recent publishing history. More than 1,300,000 copies have been sold to date.
