INDUCTEES TO *GET FURLOUGH* OF THREE WEEKS

COLUMBUS, July 2-(UP) -State selective service officials said today that Ohioans inducted after July 15 will receive approximately three weeks furlough instead of the two weeks presently granted.

Army inductees will receive the entire three weeks before reporting for service, draft officials said, but Navy, Marine Corps and Coast Guard recruits will their furloughs in two parts.

Comdr. R. H. G. Mathews, in charge of the Navy inspector's office, said the Navy will continue to give inductees a week's fur-lough before they report and 10 days when they complete "boot" training.
