His success led him to Mexico to investigate tabordillo, or Mexican typhus fever, a disease with can typhus fever, a disease with a high mortality rate and some-what similar to spotted fever.

Richetts discovered how the disease was transmitted to the human body, but while engaged in further research, he contracted tabordillo himself and died May 3, 1910, at the age of 39.
