"Salute To Youth" Program To Tell Of Heroism Of Soldier Under Fire Of German Machinegun

When wealthy Victor Holland, bachelor-about-town, is found dead in his office with a bullet in his back, police arrest his secretary, Ruth Carlin, whose exciting trial for murder will be dramatized on "Famous Jury Trials" over WJZ on Tuesday at 9 p. m. EWT.

Ruth's fingerprints on the gun, evidence that her relations were not always strictly business, and accusations that she was jealous because there were other women, too, in his gay life—all these combine to build a strong case for the prosecution. The defense attempts to prove her innocence by showing that others had not only motive but opportunity.
