Medal Given Sparta Flier

WASHINGTON — (U.P.) — The army announced today that Lieut. Col. Mark E. Hubbard, Green Bay, Wis., has been awarded the Silver Star for bravery in saving a U. S. plane trapped by two German fighters.

The citation said Hubbard, then a major, went to the aid of a lone P-40 cut off from its formation by two enemy ME-109's. Hubbard saved the P-40, shot down one enemy plane, and forced the other to flee.
