

Hall Of Fame Features Stars In Sunday Show

Quentin Reynolds, foreign correspondent and roving editor, joins the illustrious group picked to appear on the initial broadcast of the Hall of Fame Sunday, 5 to 6 p. m., EST over WJZ.

Reynolds' part in the hour-long program, which will present a portion of "Winged Victory" and separate acts by Bob Hope, Jimmy Durante, Hildegard and Maurice Rocco, the boogie-woogie pianist, will be a five-minute tribute to soldiers in greasepaint. Saluting members of the acting profession who have risked their lives to entertain the armed forces, Reynolds will recount some of his first hand experiences with troupers who have gone abroad.

Two of Hollywood's brightest stars, Virginia Bruce and Herbert Marshall, share the guest-star spotlight on the "Silver Theatre" broadcast over WABC Sunday, at 5 p. m., appearing in an original comedy-drama, "Help Wanted."

Written especially for "Silver Theatre" by Robert Riley Crutcher, "Help Wanted" presents Marshall as a famous Broadway producer en route from New York to Hollywood who is suddenly "stuck" in a small mid-western town when his train reservation is cancelled in favor of an important priority. To further complicate matters, he finds himself suddenly "adopted" by a little eight-year-old girl, who, in a similar predicament, decides to "let" him take care of her.

With Kenny Baker playing the

role created on stage and screen by Fred Astaire, Gertrude Lawrence will present bits of Cole Porter's sparkling musical, "The Gay Divorce," the show from which the song, "Night and Day" came, during the "Revlon Revue" over WJZ Sunday at 9 p. m., EST.

CRITICAL LIST FOR BUILDERS IS MODIFIED

Many items which have been restricted to builders now are available, it was announced Saturday, by Harry Wright, Jr., Lima district manager for the War Production Board.

The war housing critical list of materials has been amended to permit the use by builders of these items. Among the more important items eligible for priority assistance, subject to certain limitations, are gutters and downspouts. Use of these on structures less than three stories high is permissible when they are obtained from existing inventories of ferrous
