Pope Pius XII To Give His Christmas Message

The voice of Pope Pius XII, broadcasting his Christmas message to the world from Vatican City and celebrating the Christmas Midnight Mass at St. Peter's in Rome, will be brought to American listeners over WEAF in a program Friday at 11 a. m. EST.

A comedy, "Night Before Christmas," is the highlight of "Stage Door Canteen's" Yuletide celebration on Friday, at 9:30 p. m., over Station WABC. It stars Helen Menken with Bert Lytell and Willie Howard in the supporting roles. Frank Parker, tenor, and Nathan Milstein, the violinist, round out the guest star list. Raymond Paige's orchestra supplies the musical Christmas punch.

With Frank Black conducting the orchestra and Lucille Manners and Ross Graham joining the chorus, a group of carols, representing seven foreign countries, will be sung as a Christmas tribute. Miss Manners will also sing "Lullaby For a Doll" and "Toy Land." Ross Graham's solo will be "Sweet Little Jesus Boy." (WEAF 7 p. m. EST).
