Noted Actress On Tuesday's Ronald Colman Performance

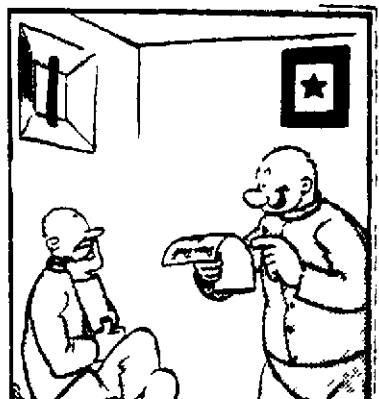
