

Betty Grable And Dick Powell Star In Comedy

Betty Grable and Dick Powell will play the stellar roles in the tuneful, musical comedy, "Springtime in the Rockies," Monday at 9 p. m. (EWT) over WABC. The full-hour dramatic show has just recently been announced the winner of the 1943 George Foster Peabody Radio Award for outstanding merit in drama.

George S. Kaufman and Moss Hart will be guest experts on "Information Please" Monday (WEAF, 9.30 p. m., EWT). The two noted playwrights are veterans of the quiz show, Kaufman having been on five times — three times as

emcee and two as expert—and Hart three times as an expert.
