

Dorsey Brothers Make Radio Appearance Thursday Night

The two distinguished brothers of the band world, Tommy and Jimmy Dorsey, will make a rare radio appearance together when they pay a visit to Bing Crosby on the "Music Hall" Thursday at 9 p. m., (EWT) over WEAF. Marilyn Maxwell and Bing's comic stooge, "Ukie" Sherin, will join the "Groaner" in extending greetings.

Harry Savoy, that Crown Prince of Confusion, buys a farm, then runs into a mirthful mix-up in trying to put it into working order, in his broadcast over Station WEAF Thursday at 10 p. m.
