

Recent Lima Visitor Guests On "Great Artists" Series

Ezio Pinza, noted basso of the opera and concert stage and recent Lima guest, returns as guest soloist on the "Great Artists Series" Monday over WEAf at 9 p. m., EWT. Donald Voorhees conducts the orchestra.
