

All-Star Baseball Game Will Be Heard Tuesday

The Tuesday broadcast of "The Doctor Fights," which stars Raymond Massey in the role of narrator, has been cancelled so that a play-by-play announcement of the annual major league All-Star baseball game may be heard.
