

Three Generals Honored In "Army Hour" Broadcast

Three commanding generals and the U. S. Army's newest officer will share the spotlight when the "Army Hour" honors the infantry Sunday, (WEAF, 2:30 p. m., EST). Lt. Gen. Omar Bradley, commanding general of the Twelfth Army Group in France (First and Third Armies; Lt. Gen. Mark Clark, Fifth Army, Italy, and Lt. Gen. Walter Kreuger, Sixth Army, Southwest Pacific, will speak direct from their theatres of operation.

The fledgling officer, however, is yet to be identified. He will be the 50,000th infantry officer to be graduated from the school at Fort Benning, Ga. Major Gen. Fred L. Walker, commandant of the school, also will participate. Another feature will be the unveiling and demonstration of several secret infantry weapons used in the invasion.

With the orchestra under the guest conductorship of Alfred Wallenstein, the "World of Song" program for Sunday features two artists who have been heard often on this WJZ network musical highlight at 3:30 p. m., EST, Regina Resnik, dramatic soprano, and Morton Bove, tenor, both members of the Metropolitan Opera and former winners of the Met Auditions of the Air.
