

New Symphonic Lionel Barrymore

A new symphonic work by Lionel Barrymore, screen actor, highlights the Indianapolis Symphony "Orchestras of the Nation," from 2 to 3 p. m. over WEAF, under the baton of Fabien Seif, the first of six air concerts the orchestra will bring the current season.
