Whether we should support Russia's proposal for Poland after the war, or should insist on re-estab-
lishing pre-war boundaries, will be the topic of discussion at "Town
Meeting," when it takes up the question "Should We Support
Plans for Poland?" in the broadcast at 7:30 p. m. Thursday
over Station WJZ.

Sir Bernard Pares, British authority on Russian affairs and
visiting professor at Toronto university, speaks for the affirmative,
with Louis Fischer, foreign correspondent and author of "Men and
Politics," on the negative. The Russian plan calls for Soviet an-
nexation of an economically unimportant but militarily important
portion of eastern Poland, giving Poland in exchange territory on
the west, taken from Germany. George V. Denny, Jr. is moderator
of "America's Town Meeting."
