TWO MINERS KILLED IN GAS EXPLOSION

SALINA, Pa., Feb. 8—(INS)—Two men were killed today in a gas explosion in the Cochran Coal Co's. pit mine near Salina, state police reported.

Police said 20 other miners walked out of the pit at the end of their shift without knowing the explosion had occurred in a mine section three miles from the pit entrance.
