Public Building Order No. 2144— Morris Building Arcadia Annex, rear of 217 N. Main St. Lima, Ohio. The use of the second and third floors as an assembly hall or any other purpose other than storage is hereby prohibited until the following order is complied with in full:

(1) Additional means of egress shall be provided from the second and third floors in the following manner. In the southwest corner a stairway shall be constructed exlending continuously from the first floor to the third floor. Stairway shall be five feet wide measuring in the clear between the handrails and shall have a uniform rise of not more than 7 not more than 7" and a uniform tread of not less than 1012".
