The dramatic life story of Lt. Gen. James H. Doolittle, who climaxed years of history-making flights by leading the first bombing raid on Tokyo and thus winning the Congressional Medal of Honor, will be heard on "Freedom of Opportunity" Friday at 8:30 p. m. over WOR.
