

Jack Carson To Be Guest On Dinah Shore Air-Show

The bubble of Jack Carson's conceit goes pop when the brawny, brainy, bragging screen star visits Dinah Shore on "Dinah Shore's Open House" broadcast at 8:30 p. m. Thursday over WEAJ.
