

Mr. And Mrs. North To Guest On "Ellery Queen" Air Show

Mr. and Mrs. North will make a neighborly social call on another private detective when they broadcast as guest armchair sleuths on the Ellery Queen program, "The Adventure of the Happy Marriage," at 7:30 p. m. Wednesday over the Columbia Broadcasting System.

Last week, the Norths were annoyed when Ellery Queen made a surprise appearance on their comedy-mystery show and solved the murder case before they did. Ellery is now giving them a chance to retaliate, for as Queen armchair sleuths the Norths have the opportunity to crack the case before Ellery does.
