Bulgar Premier, Cabinet Resign

SOFIA, Mar. 22—(UP) — The Bulgarian government headed by Premier Kimon Georgiev has resigned, it was announced today.

Georgiev's cabinet submitted its resignation last night.

Georgiev was appointed premier and minister without portfolio on Sept. 9, 1944. His government was a coalition representing the Fatherland Front, a group of left-wing parties. It was strongly pro-Soviet.
