Collett, Prosecutor Dies in Hospital

WASHINGTON COURT HOUSE, June 15—(AP)—John B. Hill, 45, Fayette-co prosecutor who sent James W. Collett to the electric chair for a triple murder three years ago, died at the Good Samaritan hospital in Cincinnati today.

Hill obtained the conviction of Collett for slaying the Elmer McCoy family Thanksgiving eve, 1943.

The prosecutor had been in failing health for several months and underwent an operation yesterday. He formerly lived in Columbus, O., where he practiced law. He was the third successive prosecutor of Fayette-co to die in office.

He is survived by his widow and a brother, Winston of Washington Court House.
