

Burns and Allen Will Return To NBC Airwaves on Sept. 5

Heralding the return of George Burns and Gracie Allen to the air Sept. 5, summertime emcee Meredith Willson sums up the musical edition of the broadcast at 7:30 p. m. Thursday over NBC. By some strange coincidences, George didn't hear any of Meredith's shows so Willson repeats the musical numbers which received the most comment.

Under the title, "The Negro to Bilbo—An Answer," a special broadcast will be carried over MBS at 9:30 p. m. from Washington. Participants in this panel discussion will be Dean Joseph L. Johnson, Howard university medical school; Charles H. Houston, general counsel of National-assn for Advancement of Colored People; Max Yergen, president of National Negro Congress.
