Artists' Colony Being Planned

CLEVELAND, Nov. 22—(AP)—A colony for writers, artists, musicians and dramatists will be established at the edge of the scenic Hocking Forest state park near Logan, O., if present plans materialize.

Proponents who met here yesterday arranged another meeting for Dec. 14 and 15 at Lorain. Persons identified with the fine arts in Cleveland, Columbus, Toledo, Dayton, Cincinnati, Canton and Akron are expected to attend.

The colony is conceived as a place where artists, writers and others would be encouraged to undertake creative work in quiet, scenic surroundings. Proponents suggested that a 500-acre tract adjoining the forest be acquired as a site, and that cabins and central dining halls and lounges be erected.
