

'Standing Room Only' Comedy- Spotlights Paulette Goddard

Paulette Goddard will make her third appearance on "Hollywood Players," Tuesday at 9:30 p. m. on CBS, to star in the hilarious comedy hit, "Standing Room Only," in which she scored a great screen hit.
