**Information for Veterans**  
(From VA, 448 State St.)

Q.—My friends tell me I would make a good salesman. Where could I get information and assistance in appraising my qualifications for the sales field?

A.—At the Veterans Guidance Center, 448 State st., Madison.

Q.—What is the maximum loan guarantee under the G.I. Bill?

A.—On a real estate the guarantee is 50 per cent of amount borrowed up to a maximum guarantee of \$4,000. Maximum guarantee on non-real estate loans is 50 per cent of amount borrowed up to \$2,000 maximum guarantee.

Q.—Are American citizens who enlisted in the Canadian army eligible for membership in the American Legion?

A.—Yes. American Legion constitution states that an American citizen at date of enlistment who served honorably in war time in armed forces of a government allied with the United States, is eligible for membership in the Legion.

Q.—If a veteran has a National Service Life Insurance Policy with a cash surrender value of \$802, what is the lean value?

A.—Loan value is 94 per cent of cash value, or \$753.88.

Q.—Is the beneficiary of a National Service Life Insurance Policy notified if the policy lapses?

A.—No, the beneficiary is not notified.
