Dulles Attacks Trade Barriers

Aid Must Promote Unity, He Declares

WASHINGTON —(U.P.)— John Foster Dulles said Friday that American aid to Europe will be "largely wasted—or worse" unless it is used to promote a "new economic unity" in western Europe.

Dulles, a leading Republican foreign policy spokesman, told the senate foreign relations committee that the Marshall plan for Europe's economic rehabilitation would fail unless this nation insisted on steps to relax artificial trade barriers. Those barriers, he said, now are dividing Europe into small economic compartments.

Dulles opened the last day of public hearings on the administration's \$597,000,000 emergency aid request for France, Italy, and Austria.

Byrd Fears Boomerang

Sen. Harry F. Byrd (D-Va.) warned of a "danger" that American aid might boomerang to Russia's benefit.

Byrd, a leader of the congressional economy bloc, told a reporter that American funds for rebuilding European industry might benefit only the Soviet Union if that country gains control of western Europe.
