Dulles Attacks Trade Barriers

Aid Must Promote Unity, He Declares

WASHINGTON -WASHINGTON -(U.P.)- John Foster Dulles said Friday that that American aid to Europe will be "largely wasted—or worse" un-less it is used to promote a "new economic unity" in western Europe.

leading Republican Dulles, а foreign policy spokesman, told the senate foreign relations committee that the Marshall plan for Europe's economic rehabilitation would fail unless this nation insisted on steps to relax artificial trade barriers. Those barriers, he said, now are dividing Europe into small economic compartsa economic compartments.

Dulles opened the last day of public hearings on the adminis-tration's \$597,000,000 emergency aid request for France, Italy, and Austria.
