3 Lose \$450,000 Suit Against Airline

MINNEAPOLIS (U.P.)— Three persons lose their \$450,000 damage suit against Northwest Airlines in a sealed jury verdict opened in district court here Thursday.

The suit was brought as the result of a crash of a C-47 plane leased to the army by NWA. Fifteen persons were killed when the craft crashed at Billings, Mont., in December, 1945. The pilot was an NWA man.
