The Bureau of Animal Industry, Department of Agriculture, has been notified that livestock inspectors are needed to aid in the foot and mouth disease campaign in Mexico.

Harry H. Johnson, Mexico City, co-director of the foot and mouth commission, stated in a telegram to the animal industry office here that applicants must have had at least five years cattle experience, be proficient in Spanish and have a high school education.

Applicants should be between the ages of 25 and 45. A representative of the commission will be at the courthouse in Uvalde through Tuesday and in Alice March 15-21 to interview applicants.

The salary for an inspector is \$3,825 a year.
