- 6:00—KFI**—Kirk Douglas' full-length portrait of the middleweight heel he played in "Champion" will be the "Screen Directors Playhouse" attraction tonight. Based on Ring Lardner's penetrating study of Midge Kelly, an arrogant and brutal character, it is a perfect picture of degradation.
- 7:00—KECA**—Willie Pep of Hartford, Conn., world featherweight champion, will lay his title on the line when he meets Ray Famechon, French fighter and featherweight champ of Europe. . . . This will be a 15-round bout from Madison Square Garden, N. Y.
- 7:00—KHJ**—Sen. Karl E. Mundt of South Dakota, who is author of the bill to deny federal employment to Communists, will "Meet the Press" tonight.
- 8:30—KECA**—Adding a touch of realism to the authentic "FBI" drama, Stan Jones, district park forest ranger and writer of the famous tune, "Ghost Riders in the Sky," will play himself, a ranger, who helps special agents capture a pair of criminals who are trying to escape in a forest fire.
