Truck Makes No Stops, But Thieves Get Loot

MILWAUKEE — (UP)— Thieves stole \$270 worth of cigarets from a non-stop freight truck en route from Milwaukee to Racine early Thursday, Sheriff Herman Kubiak said.

Truck driver Leo Hoffman said he made only traffic stops between the two cities, but when he arrived in Racine at 2 a.m. the seal on the trailer doors had been broken and three cases of cigarets were missing.

Kubiak said the thieves apparently followed the truck in an auto and looted it while it stopped for a traffic signal.
