POLE QUILTS CONSUL JOB FOR NEW REFUGEE ROLE

OTTAWA, Aug. 17—(AP) Polish Consul Zygmunt Ziemski quit his job and communist-ruled government today to become a political refugee in Canada. He said Canada agreed to let him stay.

Ziemski said he thought over the step a long time and the recent purge of high Polish army officials decided him. He cabled his resignation to Warsaw and announced it today to the Canadian Press.

Ziemski, a 59-year-old bachelor, came to Canada in 1946. Several other Polish and Czechoslovak officials in Canada have quit their posts similarly in the past.
