## 2 Killed in Crashes Near Fond du Lac

FOND DU LAC (UP)—Two persons were killed Monday in separate traffic accidents near Fond du Lac.

Gerald G. Rothmann, 29, Malone, was killed when his car left Highway 55 five miles northeast of Fond du Lac and struck a tree.

Lyle Immel, 19, Fond du Lac, died in a Fond du Lac hospital after a car in which he was riding left county Trunk H about five miles south of here and plunged down an embankment.
