Quoits Ancient

One of the world's oldest sports is "throwing the discus" it was popular in Greece 2,500 years ago.

Boys and men in ancient Greece spent a great deal of time playing with the discus, a circular plate of iron or stone. It was about the size of a modern dinner plate, but weighed about four and a half pounds.

Once in four years the Greeks were in the custom of meeting together in the Valley of Olympia. In this valley were several beautiful temples. Throwing the discus was one of the contests in the "Olympian Games," as in the modern Olympic Games.

Discus Has Rim

The standard present-day discus is made of hard wood and is rimmed with metal. It is eight inches wide and weighs about the same as an ancient discus.
