President Roosevelt's address from Green Bay, Wis., will be heard at 10:30 this morning over W-G-N via NBC. The address will be carried by WMAQ. WENR. WBBM. KYW and WCFL.

This afternoon W-G-N will broadcast the Illinois state Republican convention in its entirety from the Coliseum at the State Fair grounds, Springfield. The program will begin at 12:45 p. m. Quin Ryan, chief announcer, will be in charge of the broadcast. He will introduce the speakers, who will include Henry P. Fletcher, chairman of the national Republican committee, and C. Wayland Brooks, temporary chairman. Mr. Ryan will also comment on the program.
