"Gettysburg—The Battle That Shouldn't Have Been," an original radio drama, will be aired over W-G-N and the coast to coast network of the Mutual Broadcasting system at 6 p. m. The story, written by James Cox, who spent many years in study of the historic battlefield, will deal with four little known events which brought the armies together on a field neither of them selected for the battle.
