Another concert from Grant park will be broadcast by W-G-N from 9 to 9:30 p. m. The program will be presented by the Chicago City Opera orchestra, directed by Dino Bagalli. Selections will include the overture "La Nuit de May" and "Capriccio Espagnole," by Rimsky-Korsakov, and Menuet to "Finale from Symphony No. 13," by Haydn.

At 9:30 the Northerners' male octet and string orchestra with Bernice Rickman, soprano, will offer another of their weekly song concerts from the W-G-N main audience studio. Miss Rickman will sing "Le Filles de Cadiz," and the octet will sing "Bohemia," "Sweet Song of Long Ago," "Black Moonlight," "Too Much Harmony," and "Wake Up the Gypsy in Me." The entire cast will join in selections from "Count of Luxembourg," including the entrance chorus and "Say Not That Love Is a Dream."

Bob Elson will describe the double-header baseball game between the Chicago White Sox and Boston Red Sox, beginning at 1:30 p. m. Following the first game Bill Anson will be heard on the Swing It program with the late baseball scores, impersonations, and swing music. Elson's program of interviews with ball players, the Leadoff Man, will be heard immediately preceding the broadcast of the second game.
