Atmospheric conditions permitting, it is simple on modern receivers to pick up war news direct from European capitals. Short-wave broadcasting is confined mainly to narrow bands located approximately at 16, 19, 23, 31, and 40 meters. At this season of the year listeners usually find the 16 meter band best for European transmissions in the morning hours; the 19 meter, from noon to early evening, and the 23, 31, and 40 later. This may vary somewhat in various sections of the country.
