## UNCLE RAY'S CORNER • By Uncle Ray

**Skill Needed for Accurate Bomb-Dropping**  
Sometimes we speak of "the speed of a bullet," but when we do, it is well to remember that bullets travel at different speeds. Some rifle bullets go at the rate of a mile a second, others only 1,000 feet per second.

Airplanes have not yet reached the speed of bullets. Some of them, however, make from 500 to 600 feet in a second, or about half the speed of a bullet fired from a low powered rifle.

Bombing planes are not so fast as some other kind of war craft, but some new models can zip along at a rate up to 450 feet a second. This fact gives us an idea of the trouble a man in the plane may have in aiming at an object on the ground.

A bomb dropped from an airplane is let loose. In warfare of recent times, some cities have been bombed "in general." In other words, hundreds of bombs have been dropped in many places, without much worry about where they fell, so long as they struck some part of a city below. The object has been to spread terror among the people, and make them give up.

Thanks to bomb shelters which the people learned to use, the terror bombing did not work well in certain much-bombed cities of Spain. It caused the death of many persons who were not soldiers, but it failed to bring quick capture of the cities.

The chief help of airplane bombs to an army is in wrecking places of special value to the enemy. Such places include munition factories, airplane hangars and railway yards.

Teaching bomb-droppers to aim their bombs well has been one of the main problems of army and navy officers in late years. Students have learned, or tried to learn, just how far ahead a bomb will go from a plane moving at a certain speed and at a certain height.

In some late model planes, the bomb-dropper lies on the floor in the nose of the airplane, ahead of the pilot's seat. He looks down at the ground through a window, and lets a bomb fall when he believes the time is right.
