Bus Service for Pupils in New Housing Areas

PUPILS in housing tracts completed in the late spring and summer months for which there are no schools will get bus transportation to other areas, according to George L. Geiger, director of public elementary schools.

College Unit Three youths will be transported to schools in the downtown area. Pupils in College Unit Three bounded by Clark St., east on Mezzanine Way, south on Charlemagne Ave., (including both sides of the street) and west on Spring St. to Clark Ave. will be taken to Fremont School at Fourth St. and Roswell Ave. Pupils living in the remainder of College Unit Three, bounded by Clark Ave., Wardlaw Rd., Bellflower Blvd. and Spring St. will go to Whittier School at Seventeenth St. and Walnut Ave.

In the Lakewood Plaza tract, pupils from Woodruff Ave. and Monlaco Rd., east on Monlaco to Gondar Ave., south on Gondar to Los Coyotes Blvd., southeast on Los Coyotes to Woodruff Ave. and north on Woodruff to Monlaco Rd., will go to Willard School at Tenth St. and Free-man Ave. The others in the Lakewood tract will be transported by school bus to Lee School at Sixteenth St. and Temple Ave.

Plans are being completed to transport pupils from certain portions of Lakewood Park to McKinley and King schools in North Long Beach when housing within the Long Beach Unified School District is completed.

Details will be announced when these houses are near occupancy. These homes will not be completed and occupied when school opens on Sept. 11.

Information about where pupils will be picked up by school buses will be given to pupils at the time of registration.
