

'Quiz Kids' Set For Return To Video

"Quiz Kids," one of the best known quiz programs, returns to the air with Clifton Fadiman of "Information Please" fame as master of ceremonies, on CBS television Thursday, Jan. 12, from 10.30 to 11 p.m. The show will originate "live" from New York, and will replace "Wanted," the crime documentary series.

Fadiman, author-critic-lecturer who also was emcee of the CBS television program, "This is Show Business," will be quizmaster of a panel of four youngsters ranging in age from six to fourteen. Contributors of questions which stump the kids will receive prizes.

The program made its debut in Chicago in 1940 and was broadcast continuously for the next 13 years.

SUMMARY SOUGHT

M'CARTHY ASSAILS ACQUITTAL OF KAMIN
WASHINGTON Jan. 6 (AP)—Senator Joseph R. McCarthy has called the acquittal of Leon J. Kamin of contempt of Congress charges "ridiculous to the point of being ludicrous."

McCarthy said yesterday Federal Judge Bailey Aldrich, who ruled on Kamin's case in Boston, "should have disqualified himself since he is a member of the Board of Overseers of Harvard and Kamin was a Harvard professor."

"The decision was a foregone conclusion when the judge kicked out the jury when they heard some speculators in the hall cheering me," McCarthy said.
