

# Film Stars to Appear Cross Roll Call Hour

A galaxy of stars headed by Lionel Barrymore, Paul Muni, Judith Anderson, Raymond Massey, and Conrad Thibault will be heard over WGN, WMAQ, and WBBM in a second full hour program on behalf of the annual Red Cross Roll Call drive. The broadcast will be presented at 12:30 p. m.

An original dramatized tone poem written for radio by Charles Dillon in collaboration with Welborne Kelly, titled "Narrative in Red and White" will be featured.

The tone poem will have an original score for orchestra and chorus, written by Dr. Frank Black, with Conrad Thibault as soloist. Paul Muni, as narrator, will introduce the dramatic artists on the program. The broadcast will originate in New York and Hollywood.
